[Let the readings begin]

Isaiah 9:7

- **“You are worthy....because you were slain and with your blood you purchased men for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.**
- You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God.

- “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.
